

# Archers hit the trails at Selo Ukraina

Sixty-two archers took to the trails surrounding the Selo Ukraina site Sunday as the Vermillion Archery Club held its 18th annual 3D Archery Jamboree.

The numbers were down a bit, according to Terry Wareham of the Vermillion Archery Club, due to other commitments.

But those who did compete came from all over the province and beyond.

"We had 23 shooters from Winnipeg and we had shooters from Moose Jaw, Minnedosa, Rossburn, Teulon, Shilo and Portage. So we were pretty happy with that good cross section of people," he said, adding some of the competitors will be back in August for the national championship.

Local competitors did well, Wareham noted, with six shooters win-

ning medals, including three gold and three silver medals.

Armand Barbeau won the Dan Moriaux Memorial Award as the top local archer.

The event also served as a trial run for the computerized score keeping system, Wareham said.

"That was an important thing to put towards the nationals to make sure it's going to be in place," he said.

Planning for the national championship is going well, Wareham said. The shipment of targets from Wisconsin was expected to arrive this week.

"And our judges and officials, we've got them lined up," he added.

"We've constructed a bridge over the river so we that can access another trail, because you can't always rely on the water to be low. If the Vermillion River comes up quickly, then all of a sudden it's not something where you can go across on a couple of planks."
