Four archers attended on Saturday and all coming home with medals.

Joshua Zarichny won gold in cub compound with a score of 330; Brad Watkins won gold in hunter class with a score of 370 Armand Barbeau won silver in bow hunter fingers with a score of 332; and Michael Zarichny won bronze in masters 50 with a score of 325.

On Sunday, 10 Vermillion Archers participated, bringing home seven medals.

Zarichny won gold in cub compound with a score of 370 while Laury Brouzes won gold in masters 50 with a score of 380 Michael Zarichny won silver in masters 50 with a score of 352, Gilles Brouzes won silver in bow hunter release with a score of 365 and Brad Watkins won bronze in hunter class with a score of 367 Armand Barbeau won gold in bow hunter fingers with a score of 372 and Terry Wareham won silver in bow hunter fingers with a score of 330.

Also competing in the

bow hunter release were Derrick Burnside, Leo Brouzes and Scott Wareham.

The scores were based on two rounds of 20 targets set at unknown distances from eight to 44 yards. A perfect score would have been 400. Many archers were shooting at over 86 per cent. Laury Brouzes shot an amazing 95 per cent. A good job and good effort by all our club members.

The host Asessippi Archery Club should be commended for hosting an awesome event. In total 135 archers participated in the weekend event.
